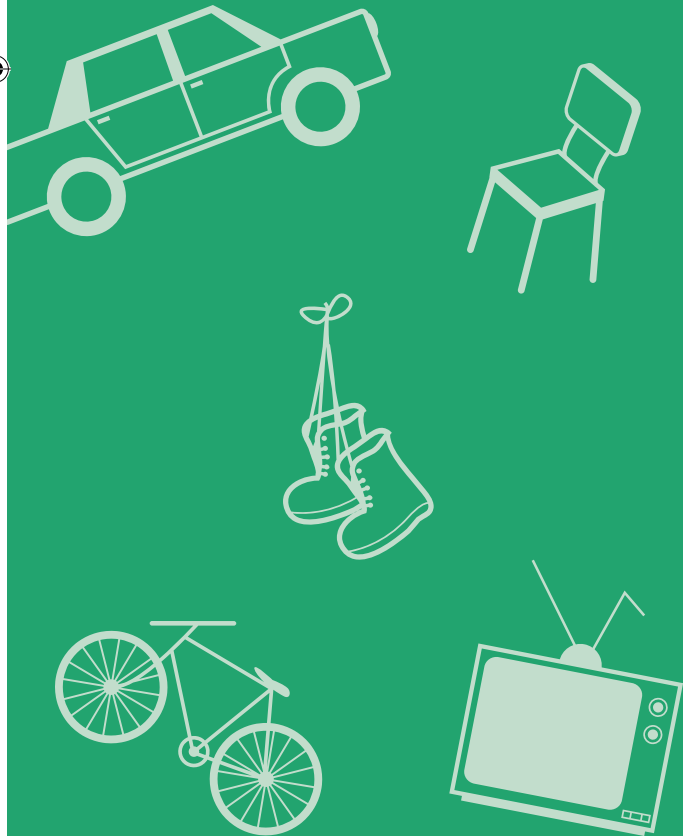

free what?

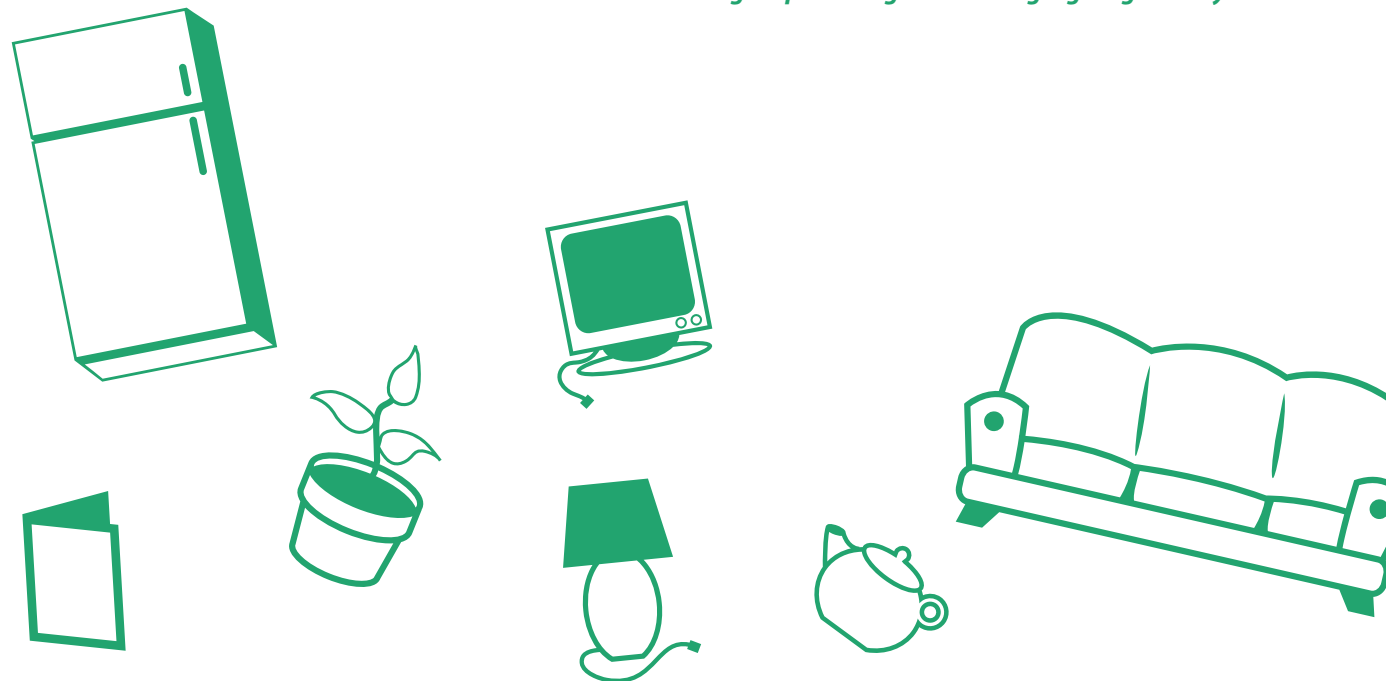
